The case was last heard in AC meeting of 21.09.2017. Based on the decision of Appellate Committee of 21.09.2017, authorization for respective blocks of GIFT city was issued vide AAI's letter dated 10.10.2017.

The applicant vide letter dated 17.10.2017 stated that keeping in view the loss of substantial built-up area to the applicant due to restrictions applied in 25 blocks (out of the total 52 blocks), the applicant requested higher heights for the remaining 27 blocks upto the heights which have been recommended in the Aeronautical Study report of GIFT City as submitted by ICAO.

The committee after perusal of the Aeronautical Study report of GIFT City as submitted by ICAO, is of the view that higher heights for 27 blocks, as requested by the applicant, is admissible upto the heights which have been recommended in the above mentioned study report.
