Minutes of the Meeting of the Appellate Committee for height clearance held on
04th July, 2017

Reference Ministry of Civil Aviation letter No. AV.20036/66/2000-AAI dated 15-10-2012 read with letters dated 31-12-2012 and dated 04-01-2013, the Appellate Committee constituted to consider appeal/grievance made by different applicants with regard to the height allocated to them by AAI for their construction vis-à-vis the height sought by them, held its meeting under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary, Ministry of Civil Aviation (MOCA) on 04th July, 2017.

The following Committee members were present:-

The aeronautical study were conducted for the following appeal cases as per the Guidelines for Aeronautical Study dated 11.07.2014 and Guidelines on Allowable Penetration of OLS dated 26th March 2015 approved by the competent authority.

The Committee while arriving at their decision in each case has considered recommendations of the Aeronautical Study Reports.

The **Aeronautical Study cases** that were brought up in this Committee Meeting are as detailed below:-

1. Shree Shyam Kripa Landmart Pvt. Ltd, Jaipur.

As per NOCAS, the proposed site lies in IHS at 2292m from Rwy 09 beginning of Jaipur Airport. The applicant had requested for a height of 449.6m AMSL online dated 06.12.2014 against which they were granted a height of 429.96m AMSL vide AAI letter dated 02.03.2015. The applicant had revised their height requirement to 449m AMSL and also requested for Aeronautical Study vide letter dated 25.07.16.

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The Competent Authority on 07.04.2017 approved the conduct of an Aeronautical Study for a height of 449m AMSL which is also recommended by Jaipur Development Authority. The Committee was informed that Aeronautical Study has indicated the permitted top elevation (which is the minimum as derived from AGA, CNS and PANS-OPS criteria) as 448.4m AMSL.

Committees' Decision:

The permitted top elevation (P.T.E.) of 448.4m AMSL is approved.

As per NOCAS, the proposed site lies in IHS at 3199m from Rwy 09 of Hyderabad Airport. The applicant had requested for 585.5m AMSL online dated 03.11.2016 against which they were granted height of 574.8m AMSL vide AAI letter dated 10.11.2016. The applicant had revised their height requirement to 583.5m AMSL and also requested for Aeronautical Study vide letter dated NIL.

The Competent Authority on 20.04.2017 approved the conduct of an Aeronautical Study for a height of 583.5m AMSL which is also recommended by Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation.

The Committee was informed that Aeronautical Study has indicated the permitted top elevation (which is the minimum as derived from AGA, CNS and PANS-OPS criteria) as 583.5m AMSL.

Committees' Decision:

The permitted top elevation (P.T.E.) of 583.5m AMSL is approved.

Other Decisions

4. A note was put up for Appellate Committee to consider the view of AAI legal cell in respect of Appellate Committee decision to appeal against the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi order dated 12.04.2017.

Appellate Committee was of the opinion that long term implications of repeat Aeronautical Study by ICAO should be examined by AAI. Further, Appellate Committee noted that Aeronautical Study is not a matter of right of any applicant. The Committee decided that AAI to take appropriate decision after due assessment of all aspect involved.

5. The Appellate Committee approved the proposal of AAI to re-constitute a sub-committee (Shielding Committee), constituting of the following Officers,

to assess the permissible top elevation with respect to shielding criteria as per para 4, schedule II of GSR-751(E):-
